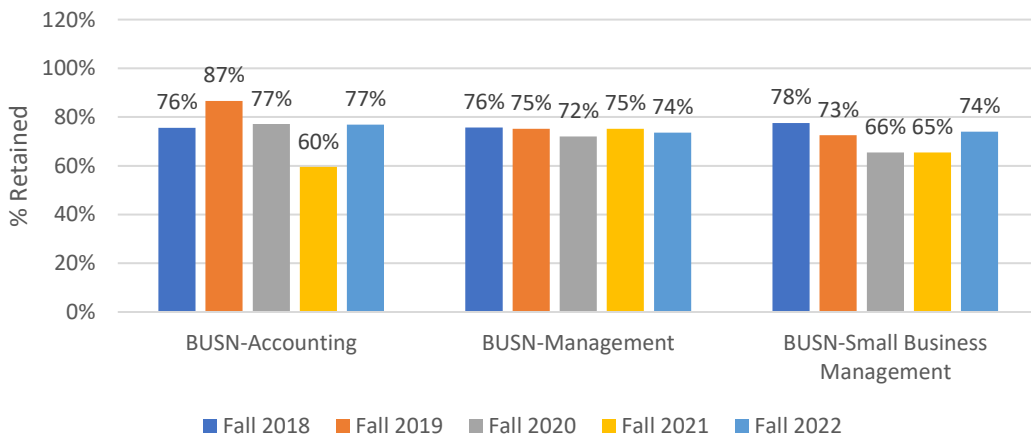
## ACBSP ACCREDITED PROGRAM PERFORMANCE 2018-2023

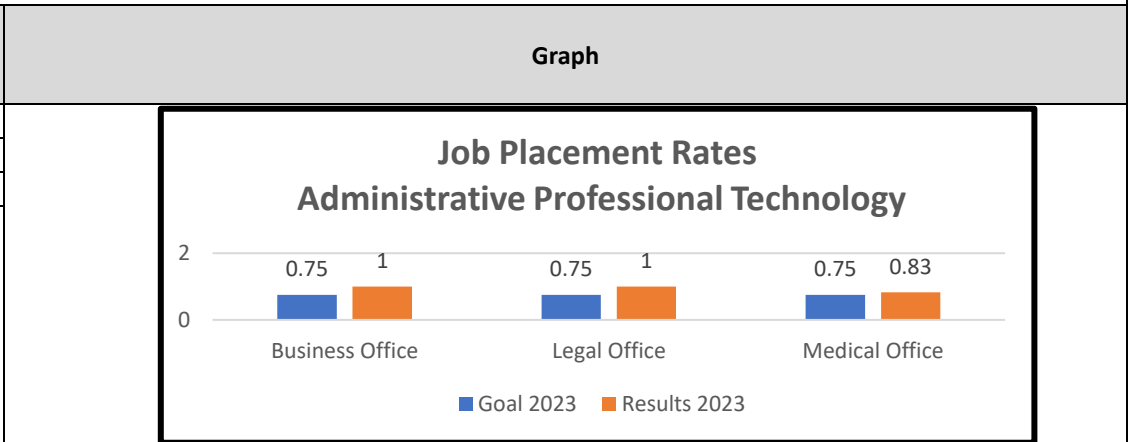

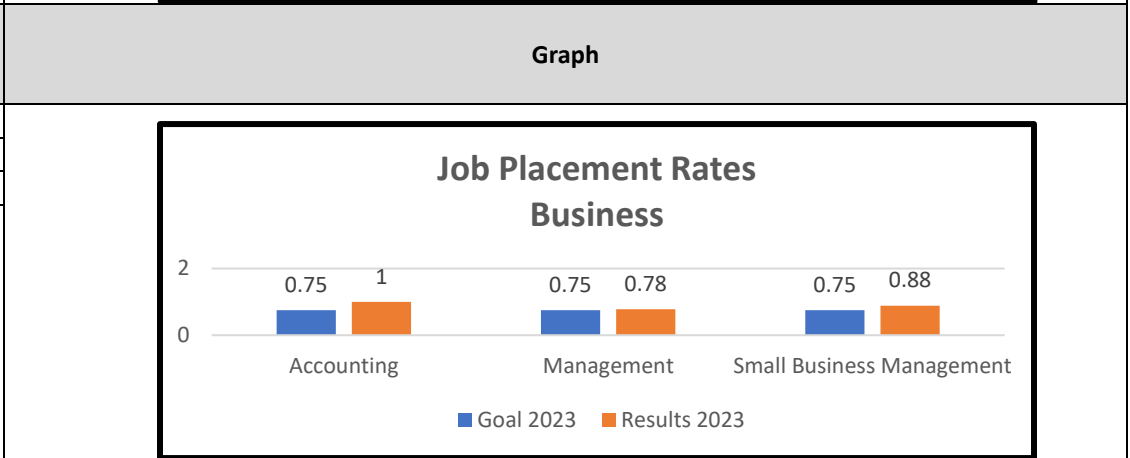
