Go to the [AIMT Database](#) and search for your text by Vendor. You can choose to search by Name, but it is easier and more accurate to do it by vendor.

Once the list opens, search for your text. If it is on the list, check the conformance status under Conformance. You can view the uploaded documents, such as the VPAT or accessibility statements, under Documentation/Info.
