

Registration Information



Spring 2025 Registration

Spring 2025 registration for current students begins **Monday**, **November 4 at 7:30 a.m.** Students can register online through their **MyNortheast** account.

Current Students

If you're working toward a degree or certificate, you must meet with an academic advisor before registering for classes. There will be an advising hold on your account, which means you will not be able to add or drop classes until you have met with your advisor. You can schedule an appointment with your advisor using the <u>online scheduling system</u>. See the <u>Advising Requirement</u> page on how to schedule an appointment. Registration for Spring 2025 classes begins on Monday, November 4 at 7:30 a.m. Once you have been cleared by your advisor, you can register online through your <u>MyNortheast</u> account.

First-Time College Students

If this is your first time attending college, you will register for your classes during your new student advising and registration day. You will receive a letter in the mail with instructions on how to sign up for a date. Registration and advising for new students will take place from December 2024 until the first day of classes. (Spring 2025 classes start on January 21.)

Advising Requirement

Required Advising for Students

All students are **<u>REQUIRED</u>** to meet with an advisor before registering for classes each semester.

How to Schedule an Advising Appointment

- 1. Log in to <u>MyNortheast</u>, click on the link for Degree Works (under *Student Advising Tools*)
- 2. Enter your student ID number into the search bar
- 3. In the third section of your Degree Works audit, click the link that reads: "Scheduling an appointment with your faculty advisor is required each semester. Click here to schedule an appointment."


