## **DUAL CREDIT PATHWAY FORM**

## Students:

To receive credit for a dual credit exam you have taken, you must:

- 1. Pass the Northeast State Community College (NeSCC) dual credit course exam. Most classes require a score of 70% or better to receive credit for the course. Health-related classes require a score of 84% or better to receive credit for the course.
- 2. Enroll at NeSCC within two years of high school graduation or be dual enrolled at NeSCC while in high school.
